## **Pottery**

Adult pottery classes are open to beginners and intermediates. The curriculum includes hand-building, wheel throwing, glaze application and decorative techniques on high-fired stoneware. Because clay melts at different temperatures, only pots made in our studio with clay supplied by the Pottery may be fired in our kilns. Clay and tools cost extra. Glaze materials and firing are included in the cost of clay. All classes meet regardless of holidays, unless otherwise noted. 16 Students max.

Bench times are offered to students at no extra charge. We are returning to the bench time system we had pre-covid. Please read carefully to understand what days you will have access to the clay studio.

## Four and Eight Harness Weaving

The beginner is introduced to all steps of weaving including winding a warp, threading a loom, reading a draft, and weaving a variety of patterns. Finishing techniques will also be covered. The Intermediate student receives individualized instruction and is encouraged to explore the diversity of the craft. Materials are extra. 9 students max. All weaving classes are held on our second floor weaving studio which is only accessible by stairs.
